



ORIGAMI THROWING STAR SCHEMATICS




01 Fold a square sheet of paper across the centre and cut in half to make two rectangles.




02 Fold the halves in half to make narrower rectangles.




03 Fold both sheets down in half, then unfold to reveal crease.




04 Fold the top half to the side as shown without passing the halfway crease.




05 Fold the lower half of both sheets opposite of the upper half.




06 Turn both paper over so they match the positions as shown.




07 Fold the top squares of both sheets in half as shown.




08 Fold the bottom squares of both sheets in half as shown.




09 Fold the top triangles in as shown,




10 Fold in the bottom triangles of both sheets.




11 Unfold the top and bottom triangles of both sheets.




12 Turn the right sheet over and position it exactly as shown.




13 Place the right sheet on top of the left sheet.




14 Tuck the right and left of the bottom sheet under the left and right side of the top sheet.




15 Turn the figure over.



16 Tuck the above flap into the pocket of the top sheet.



17 Tuck the lower flap into the other pocket of the top sheet.



18 You're finished - now go thwart Carmen!
